The Heartsaver AED Course is a classroom course that teaches basic CPR and AED skills including giving CPR to a child or an adult, using an Automated External Defibrillator (AED), using a mask or barrier device, and relief of foreign-body airway obstruction. Course includes a brief practical examination.
